SCHEME FOR POST MATRIC SCHOLARSHIPS FOR STUDENTS BELONGING TO THE
MINORITY COMMUNITIES

Good news for minority students perusing higher education, classes XI up to Ph.D. and technical and vocational courses of class XI and XII level.

Applications are invited from students belonging to minority communities (Muslim and Christian in Kerala) notified by the Central Government, perusing higher education from class XI up to PhD and technical and vocational courses of industrial training institutes / industrial training centers (affiliated with NCTV) in Govt.school/college/institute recognized by appropriate authority for post metric scholarships to be awarded by the Ministry of Minority affairs, Govt. Of India. Applications in the prescribed format along with requisite documents should be submitted to the Special Officer for Scholarships, Directorate of Collegiate Education (Annex), Sanskrit College Campus, Thiruvananthapuram latest by 31-1-2008 through the Head of school/college/institute being attested or last attended by the student. The last date for receipt of application is 31st January 2008. The application format and all details of the scholarship scheme are available in the department website viz. www.collegiateedu.kerala.gov.in and in Govt. Of India website <http://minorityaffairs.gov.in>.

The scholarship will be awarded for studies in India only.

To be eligible, students should have not less than 50% marks in the previous final examination. Students from BPL families, having the lowest income will be given preference in the ascending order. A scholarship holder under the scheme will not avail any other scholarship/stipend for perusing the same course. The annual income from all sources, of he students' parents or guardian should not exceed Rs.2 lakhs. 30% scholarships will be earmarked for girl students. Further, scholarship will not be given to more than two students in a family.

Along with the application, a self attested passport size photograph (affixed on the application) with signature, attested copies of certificates of educational qualifications from S.S.L.C. onwards, Income certificate or income declaration-affidavit as mentioned vide column 19(iii) of the application form, proof of permanent residence, community certificate or minority community declaration-affidavit vide column 19(iv) of the application form etc. should be submitted.

All columns of the application should be properly filled up. Incomplete applications/those without required documents cannot be considered.
